# **ITEMS DISCUSSED:**

# 1. President's Corner (Mr. David Perkins absent)

- April Lewis called the meeting to order at 11:30.
- Corrections to the minutes were made and April called for a vote to approve the minutes of the August Board meeting as corrected. The minutes were approved.

# 2. Secretary's Report (Mr. Ken Stegall/ Mr. Drew Titone)

- The August minutes were presented, reviewed and approved with minor corrections.

# 3. Treasurer's Report (Ms. Jennifer Russell on TDY/ Mr. Joe DiMisa

- A detailed report was emailed to the Board members prior to the meeting. In summary, for September there were \$73,493.26 expenses for the Regional Conference, \$480.96 expenses for treasurer credit card processing and cash box, and \$25.95 for the website. Income for September was \$9,552.51 from the Regional Conference. Overall for the year, income exceeds expenditures.
- Other expenses are outstanding for the Regional. The Post has not been invoiced for the ribbons. Also, the Museum and Officer's Club have not cashed checks. There are also outstanding expenses for the golf outing although, the final costs will be less than the income. Carillon Park has not invoiced for drink tickets. Overall the Regional income is greater than expenses. Credit card processing for the Regional will close October 15<sup>th</sup>. Alan Hautman has the template for the after action report for preparation and sending to HQ SAME within 90 days.

- Joe asked for assistance at the next luncheon because the credit card swipe machine has required maintenance and payment may need to be manually typed into a laptop and it would help to have someone taking cash and check payments in a separate line.
- BCEs will reimburse the Post after the luncheon for their meal costs.
- Nick Scambilis reported that the scholarship funds carry-over from Sinclair was awarded to 3 students. The post will recognize these new recipients in May.
- Joe asked that everyone think about their budgets for next year.
- Jon Wheeler of the Readiness Committee reported that there will be an expense for attending the TISP Dec 7 thru 9. HQ SAME pays the registration fee this year, but not the expenses. A vote was taken at the meeting to approve \$750 for expenses Jon to attend. This was later amended to \$1,000 after the meeting by email concurrence from the Board members, because the \$750 was not enough to cover all the travel, lodging and meal expenses. Jon will provide a budget to Joe for participation again in 2011 as required for eligibility for the Readiness Streamer award.
- Mark Golz stated that Capt. Chun provided pizza for the AFIT promotional membership meeting and should be sending a bill to Joe for reimbursement.

- When Kim arrived she reported that approx.. 1.2% to 1.3% of Post dues and \$45 per Sustaining Member dues are paid back to the Post. It is understood that this is direct deposited into the Post account.
