ITEMS DISCUSSED:

- 1. President's Corner (Mr. Alan Hautman presiding / Ms. April Lewis absent.)
 - Special thanks to Mr. Brad Doudican and Mr. Todd Butler for the website. The new site launch went very well and a lot to cover so let's go
- 2. Secretary's Report (Mr. Ted Hecht/ Mr. Drew Titone assistant)
 - The Nov minutes were presented, reviewed and approved. Note that the minutes need to be also posted to the web site and sent to the base org rep.

- 4. Treasurer's Report (Ms. Andrea Pakulski/Mr. Pete Battaglia)
 - Basketball game reservations going well especially young members.
 - Industry Roundtable went well with registrations of \$2400 and expenses of \$240. Quite a successful event.

- Ms.Andrea Pakulski presented a problem with tracking credit card payments to the
 event since they do not correlate. Possibly on EventBrite we can see the numbers.
 Somehow they can be correlated with registrations.
- 2010 Taxes are paid
- Ms.Andrea Pakulski passed out the budget for review
 - Alan reported some funds were set aside to the President's Award for the award recipient's luncheon costs.
 - o Programs was not completely resolved.
 - Education budget was noted as busting the budget. Explanation is that the selection board was generous and granted another scholarship. Discussion of the way it was presented and corrections possibly needed. Income and scholarships were equal.
 - O Some discussion of the luncheon cost. Discussion of the \$1.36 on a \$15.00 (Todd was right) ticket for the ticket fee if you pay on the site or if you pay at the door it costs a nominal fee. Further discussions of other post fee structure and how we get people to not default to pay at the door. Lunches cost \$14.00 at the Club. Proposal is \$10.00 for government and \$20.00 for nongovernment with a six month trial period. Math showed that there should be an increase in revenue. Motion was approved. Budget will be adjusted.
 - o Mr. Joe DiMisa indicated that some adjustment in the education amounts for scholarships need to be accounted for in the budget.
 - o General comment by Mr. Alan Hautman the online registration is preferred and we should be working towards discouraging walk ins such as a penalty.
 - Engineers tried to discuss accounting for scholarships donated by others and how they are shown which became a big problem. Heads began to hurt and it was tabled. Accountants will be consulted.
