MEMBERSHIP MEETING: 10 May 2012
UD River Campus Dayton, Industry Day (second Thursday)

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

1. **President's Corner (Mr. Alan Hautman absent / Ms. April Lewis)**
 - As members arrived at the usual Building 11 meeting site the area had been cordoned off as part of a military exercise. Some of the board members were not available since they became involved in the exercise or were diverted by security forces. All remaining board members that could be contacted held the meeting at the Flying Tiger, a local restaurant, located just outside Gate 1A, a few blocks from Building 11. April Lewis called the meeting to order there at approximately 11:45.
 - April thanked everyone for attending the meeting despite the confusion and asked for the Secretary's Report
2. **Secretary's Report (Mr. Ted Hecht absent/ Mr. Drew Titone assistant)**
 - Minutes from last month were presented and approved with a correction to the membership numbers.

3. **Post calendar is attached.**
4. **Treasurer's Report (Ms. Andrea Pakulski absent/Mr. Pete Battaglia)**
 - Mr. Pete Battaglia presented the treasurer's report to the board, it had previously been provided to the board via email.
 - There was a discussion about the way the lunch expenses are currently presented in the Treasurer's report. The expenses are shown for the prior month but income is for the month earlier. Board members requested that expenses and income be shown for the most

recent month possible so that the board can track losses or gains from each meeting to see if adjustments to the cost of lunch are needed.

- The post most likely lost between \$400 and \$600 at the April lunch since many government employees attended.

- We received a letter from the IRS on 3-26-12 charging SAME Kittyhawk post with a penalty (\$2780.) for submitting an incomplete tax form for 2010. I submitted this letter to our tax preparer Ellen Fodge C.P.A. and she is following up on this matter with the IRS. The nature of the incomplete filing seems to be a box was not checked indicating that a list of contributors was not required.

Committee Reports

5 Membership (Ms. Kim Duncan / Mr. Joe DiMisa)

- Ms. Kim Duncan reported that the post has 182 (down 1) individual members and 237 (up 5) SREPS for a total of 419 (against our goal of 430 for 2012 which is being verified). The post also has 22 (same) Student Members.
- April Lewis noted that HQ AFMC and the 88th are both downsizing which will likely lead to a smaller number of members for the post.
- As of next month the membership responsibilities will transfer from Kim Duncan to Joe DiMisa.

- Kim reported that the reports on the SAME national post have been updated and improved and now match our actual membership numbers.

6 Sustaining Membership (Ms. Rose O’Grady)

- Ms Kim Duncan reported we have 59 Sustaining Members firms. Up 1. The new firm is ADB Airfield Solutions
- There will be no Sustaining Member presentation at the May luncheon.

7 Programs (Mr. Jeff Leonard /Ms. Nadja Turek/Kirk Zecchini absent)

- Nadja Turek presented the program, attached, for the May meeting. It is being held in conjunction with Industry Day.
- The new SAME officers and Board members will be sworn by Marci Snyder and the new president will run the meeting. As Co-President Col Todd will preside since April Lewis will not be able to attend.
- The guest speaker will be BGen Burcham, commander of the COE Great Lakes and Ohio River Division.
- There will be no sustaining member speaker
- The June 14th meeting will be back at the Club at Wright Patt. It will be a joint meeting with the Dayton Society of Professional Engineers, who will provide the speaker. A SAME Sustaining member will be invited to present their firm at the meeting. Marci Snyder will look in to inviting Dr. Wolfe to the meeting as a guest only. He will not be a featured speaker but may give a short talk similar to a SM presentation.

- The scholarship committee selected 12 winners including 4 Barnes scholarship winners. Letters have been sent to the winners informing them of their awards and inviting them to our June meeting.
- An additional Barnes scholarship was funded by donations from The Frank Family, AEC, Gannett Fleming, and URS.
- There will be a representative from Sinclair at the meeting to accept their scholarships.

9 Industry Affairs (Mr. Ken Stegall /Mr. John Koerner absent ,)

- Ken Stegall reported that everything is ready for Industry Day on May 10th with over 20 speakers. Opening remarks begin at 7:45 and the final session ends at 4:15.
- At the time of the board meeting 64 people had signed up for industry day assuring that the post would cover expenses for the event.
- Registration will be in the lobby with signs with directions to rooms and events.
- Ken asked for board members to serve as facilitators in the training rooms.
- Ken tried to sign up speakers on Eventbrite but didn’t have any luck. He will try again as Jeff Leonard said is should work.
- Jeff noted that for government computers the security system is blocking the active “sign up” button. There is a work around which Jeff will send out when requested.

- Capt Hudson provided this report via e-mail:
- Capt Justin Meihaus was selected to attend the JETC conference sponsored by SAME Kittyhawk.
- There are 12 YM from the Kittyhawk post attending the SAME JETC conference. Most of the YM attending qualified for the JETC scholarship offered by SAME. SAME National is not paying for the first night of the conference since activities technically do not start until the afternoon on Tues. We are recommending the YM pull \$100 (the cost of the hotel room is \$104/night + tax) scholarships to each YM attending the conference to help cover costs, since most members are driving and are planning to arrive on Monday afternoon. Please let us know if this is okay with the board and we will proceed.
- The board members discussed the request for the additional \$1200 to cover the hotel costs for the young members. They felt that the post could not afford this unbudgeted expense. The authorized the use of any budgeted funds that were not used by Capt Meihaus could be used to help cover the expenses of other attend YMs.
- With the number of YM attending the JETC, Amanda and Justin are trying to work out a joint social event. One idea that was brought up was to attend a St. Louis baseball game on Monday night.

12:30 **Guest Speaker:** Brigadier General Margaret Burcham (Col Todd)

BIO: Brigadier General Margaret W. Burcham took command of the Great Lakes and Ohio River Division, headquartered in Cincinnati Ohio, on September 19, 2011. The division has seven engineer

districts totaling over 4800 people operating in a seventeen state area, and is charged with directing federal water resource development in the Great Lakes and Ohio River basins with infrastructure valued at over \$80 billion. With an annual operating and construction budget exceeding \$2 billion, missions include planning, construction and operations of navigation structures and flood damage reduction, hydropower, environmental restoration, water conservation, recreation and disaster assistance. The division also executes military construction in Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, Illinois and Michigan with design and construction of barracks, hospitals, airfields and family housing on military installations.

General Burcham was commissioned into the Corps of Engineers upon graduation from West Point. She holds a master's in Computer Science from Kansas State University as well as extensive military education. She has served worldwide in her career, but most recently on the Joint Staff in the Pentagon, as the commander of the Europe District of the Army Corps of Engineers as well as the Gulf Region North District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in Iraq.
