MEMBERSHIP MEETING: 11 June 2015

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

1. **President's Corner (Ms. Nadja Turek)**
 - Mike Howe welcomed the Board to the meeting.

2. **Secretary (Mr. Joe Pado / Mr. Joe Brink & Mr. Drew Titone assistants)**
 - Joe Pado presented the draft minutes from the May Board Meeting. No further changes were requested and the minutes were approved as presented.
 - Joe Pado led a discussion on Post By-Laws revisions. He stated that the proposed draft By-Laws were uploaded to the Post's website and a message was sent to all Post members to review them. If no serious objections were noted, the proposed By-Laws will be voted on during the next membership luncheon scheduled for 11 June. During this discussion, it was proposed that the By-Laws be amended to include a Post President rotation. 
22. New Business:


