MEMBERSHIP MEETING: 14 May 2015

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

1. **President's Corner (Mr. Ted Hecht)**
 - Nadja Turek welcomed the Board to the meeting.
2. **Secretary (Mr. Joe Pado / Mr. Joe Brink & Mr. Drew Titone assistants)**
 - Joe Pado presented the draft minutes from the April Board meeting. No further changes were requested and the minutes were approved as presented.

 - Pete provided the Treasurer's Report prior to the meeting (see attached). Pete briefed the report to the Board. No concerns were noted.
