#### ITEMS DISCUSSED:

#### 1. President's Corner (Ms. Nadja Turek)

- Nadja welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- Nadja then stated that Post Officer elections are coming-up this May. It was noted that the
  Post's preference would be to have Vice President nominees come from Private Industry this
  year as to ensure the Post can honor the intent to rotate leadership positions between Private &
  Government sectors each year. She also stated that Jeff Todd and Ken Stegall will oversee
  this year's elections process.
- Nadja reported that SAME National is leading an initiative to interview and record stories from the Vietnam War. She asked that if any member knows a veteran who may be interested that they should let her know.
- Nadja stated that National elections are in progress and former Kittyhawk Post Board member, Ben Matthews is on the ballot as Young Members Rep.
- Nadja discussed this year's JETC attendance (late-May). It was stated that Mike Howe and Jeff Leonard will attend. Others are also considering attendance.

#### 2. Secretary (Mr. Joe Pado / Mr. Joe Brink & Mr. Drew Titone assistants)

• Joe Pado presented the draft minutes from the February Board meeting. No significant changes were requested and the minutes were approved as presented.

#### 3. Treasurer (Mr. Pete Battaglia / Ms. Bronnie Kallas)

- Prior to the meeting, Pete provided the March Treasurer's Report. No concerns were noted with his report.
- The Board discussed, then approved an additional \$50 to cover half of the expenses incurred during the jointly-manned, ASCE/SAME exhibit at this year's TechFest (13-14 March). The Post contributed a total of \$200 from the Young Member's budget to participate in this year's event.

- Joe DiMisa stated that he coordinated with Communications Committee to provide web-blasts and "thank you for joining" messages on the Post's website and social media platforms. Joe also stated that he is working to ensure the website/social media platforms have direct joining links to SAME National's membership sign-up site.
- Joe DiMisa reported that he is reaching-out to AFIT Instructors to get them to join SAME.
- Joe DiMisa stated that he continues to develop an info sheet on the benefits of SAME membership (for both individual and sustaining memberships).

Last year the Stevenson Road Covered Bridge restoration was completed and in 2014 the Engle Mill Road Covered Bridge was completed. Both were Smith Trusses manufactured in Tipp City by the Smith Bridge Company. This presentation will focus on the bridge work Mr. Geyer is doing in Greene County.

**BIO:** Bob is a 1966 graduate of Xenia High School and a 1971 graduate of Purdue University. After graduation from Purdue, Bob worked for Bechtel Corporation in San Francisco for two years before returning to Xenia to work for then Greene County Engineer Ray Kline. Bob left the county in 1979 to work for Danis Heavy and Highway Division building roads and bridges in Ohio and West Virginia where he was the Project Engineer on the largest public works project in West Virginia at the time, a \$60 million renovation of a section of the West Virginia Turnpike. In November 1996 Bob was elected Greene County Engineer where he has worked for the last 19 years to make Greene County a better place to live, work, and play.


