ITEMS DISCUSSED:

- 1. President's Corner (Mr. Mike Howe)
 - No initial comments.
- 2. Secretary (Mr. Joe Pado / Mr. Joe Brink & Mr. Drew Titone assistants)
 - The minutes from the October Board meeting were approved as presented.
 - Joe Pado stated the he renewed the Post's permission to operate on Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB) with the installation's Private Organization Office.

 - Michael Chapman stated that Mr. Bob Draper & Mr. Joe Brink from Burgess & Niple will be the November Luncheon's Sustaining Member Firm Presenter.
- 6. Programs (Ms. Nichole Lashley / Ms. Nadja Turek/ Mr. Jeff Leonard/ Ms. Teri French/ Mr. Amir Mott)
 - The agenda for the November luncheon was discussed (see attached).
 - It was announced that Amir Mott from the 88th Civil Engineer Group will join the Programs Committee.
 - Additional ideas for future luncheon presentations were discussed:
 - Deployment Perspectives brief by the returning WPAFB Fire Chief Jacob King
 - ODOT Repairs to the Damaged I-70/I-75 Interchange

- 8. Industry Affairs (Mr. Ken Stegall / Mr. Scott Porter / Mr. Joe Brink /Mr. Norm Campbell)
 - It was reported that there will be no USACE Conference and Small Business Roundtable event this year.
- 9. Small Business (Mr. Jeffery Engram / Ms. Rosie O'Grady / Mr. Scott Porter) - Post Small Business Liaison Officer (Mr. Scott Porter)
 - No report.
- 10. 2017 JETC Planning (Mr. Jeff Todd / Sam Reed)
 - Sam Reed provided a Committee report via e-mail. Below is report:
 - The contract with the Columbus Convention Center has been signed.

- The goal is to open 2017 JETC registration in mid-December.
- Ann McCleod from SAME National has received an initial floor plan for the exhibit hall and has some work to do on it. She hopes to have the booth selection lottery ready in mid-December. National will be getting an email out to past exhibitors soon.
- Sponsorship opportunities are pretty much solidified. Attached is a copy of the sponsorships that are planned to be offered.
- The Ice Breaker will be held at the Columbus Center of Science and Industry (COSI). The contract with COSI not yet been signed. They are apparently going back-and-forth with them on some contract language.
- We are looking at having two tours on May 23. One will be at Ohio Stadium and the other at the new National Veterans Memorial & Museum which is currently under construction in downtown Columbus. We are working out details with both and hope to have confirmation by early December.
- I have contacted both the Ohio National Guard and The Ohio State University's ROTC program to see about having one of them provide a Color Guard for the event. The Ohio National Guard can most likely help. The ROTC group might be able to but it depends upon the number of students still on campus after the end of Spring semester.
- Although not directly associated with the JETC, a Golf Outing has been scheduled and will be held at the Muirfield Village Country Club (a Jack Nicklaus-designed course)
- 11. Emergency Preparedness & Infrastructure Resilience (EP&IR) (Mr. Jon Wheeler / Maj Michael Spencer)
 - No report.
- 12. Social (Mr. Dave Perkins / Mr. Robert Blevins)
 - Robert Blevins stated that the Lucky Star Brewing Company in Miamisburg, OH will be the site of the Post's Holiday Social on 01 December. Event will start at 6 PM.

Dave requested that the Post financially back this commitment so that the contract can be signed. The Board committed support to this event and authority was to financially obligate the Post for this event was granted.
